

## 2018-2019 HIB Grade

Since the 2011-2012 school year, Lawrence Township School District has conscientiously implemented the requirements outlined in the Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act (ABR) of 2011.

Each year the New Jersey Department of Education releases Harassment, Intimidation, and Bullying (HIB) grades for each school and district in the state, based on a self-assessment that all districts are required to complete in the fall after each school year.

For the 2018-2019 school year, Lawrence Township, Cumberland County earned a score of 70, where the maximum score that could be earned is 78. With a score of 70, Lawrence Township is exceeding the requirements set forth in the anti-bullying legislation.

The grade for the 2019-2020 school year will be released in the spring of 2021.
